Be sure to keep the following in mind before you pack your bags:

- The Post Office. Visit the U.S. Postal Service's online movers guide or stop by your local office to fill out a change of address card so your mail will be forwarded.
- The IRS. Print out and mail in the IRS' Change of Address form.
- Credit card companies. Remember your store cards and loyalty programs!
- **Banks.** You may want immediate access to your checking account on moving day, as well as update online banks information, retirement funds and investment accounts.
- **Utility Companies.** Schedule shut-off at your old address for the end of moving day and arrange service at your new home.
- **Home or Renters' Insurance.** Be sure your possessions are covered during transport, especially if you have valuables in your own vehicle.
- Car Insurance.
- Health Insurance.
- Your Doctor. Have your current medical files transferred and get recommendations for new physicians.
- **Government Agencies.** If you receive benefits from Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid or any other government program, notify them before you move.
- **Phone and Internet.** Discontinue service at your old location and schedule new service.
- Cell Phone Provider.
